EnviroWatts® Project Guidelines

Funding from the EnviroWatts® Fund is available for non-profit, service organizations for environmentally friendly projects that will benefit the LaGrange County REMC service area. These Project Guidelines have been created to assist those who are submitting an application for funding by identifying those environmental projects more likely to be considered acceptable. Even though a project might seem to fit well within these Guidelines, LaGrange County REMC reserves the right to fund or the right not to fund any particular project. LaGrange County REMC is limited by monies available in the fund. This may result in only a few projects being funded out of a number of well-deserving projects.

Types of projects that might be funded by EnviroWatts® include:

- Develop renewable energy sources and resources
- Reduce energy use
- Improve water quality of rivers, streams and underground aquifers
- Improve air quality of local area
- Enhance species diversity
- Create or restore habitat for wildlife
- Plant trees or native plants
- Encourage recycling
- Educate individuals about safe disposal of waste, especially hazardous/chemical waste
- Educate the public on local environmental issues

Applicants will be advised of the decision of LaGrange County REMC regarding their funding in early April. Recipients will be asked to pick up their checks at our office at an agreed time. A press release may be printed in the Electric Consumer, area newspapers, and issued to local radio stations, as desired by the REMC to promote the EnviroWatts® program.
